Randy Waters brought the club up to date on the status of State of Jefferson.

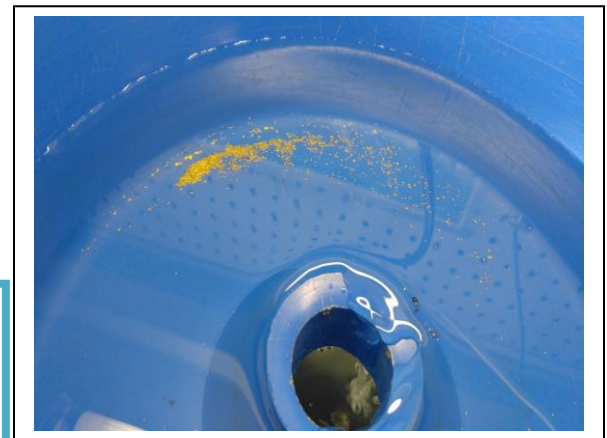

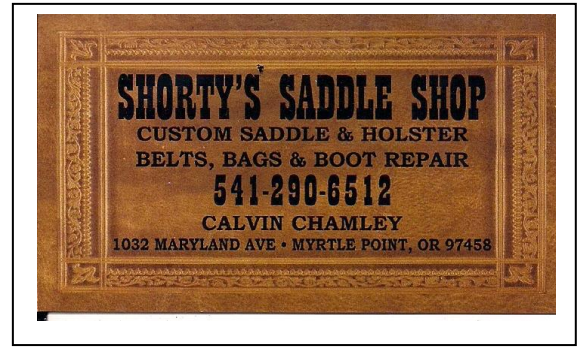
